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EARLY YEARS CURRICULUM OVERVIEW Spring Term

Class Teacher	Miss Raval
Teaching Assistants	Mrs Banitsiotis
PE days	Thursday (children do not need a change of clothes or shoes)
Day homework is set	Children should be reading daily and should draw a picture in their reading diaries.
Day homework is due in	Your child's reading book will be changed weekly depending on which group they are: Monday-Sharks Tuesday-Crabs Wednesday-Octopuses Thursday-Puffer Fish Friday-Turtles.
Literacy overview	We are focusing on: Transport and Vehicles Reading: - Children will be practising blending CVC words to read them. They will also begin to read some simple sentences. We shall be looking at different types of texts particularly fiction books and non-fiction books. Writing: Children will continue to practice writing CVC words, high frequency words, making lists and labelling and shall begin writing some simple sentences. Spoken Language: Children will be able to retell stories and information that they have learnt from memory about transport. Share their ideas and explore and explain how and where they would like to travel to. Children will begin using 'because' 'and' 'then' and 'the' to extend sentences verbally.
Phonics overview	Focus on Set 1 RWI Sounds and Set 2 Sounds.
Amount of time which should be spent reading every day	10-20 mins
Library book day	Your child's book will be changed on the day stated above.
Maths overview	We are focusing on: Number: - Children will continue their learning on number



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	<p>sequencing and ordering, 1 more and one less and addition. We shall also be introducing subtraction to the children and will be working on solving addition and subtraction problems and writing number sentences. We will also be consolidating children's number formation.</p> <p>Shape: - We will be learning about 3D and 2D shapes and using mathematical language such as corners, faces and sides to compare and sort shapes.</p> <p>Measure- We will be continuing our learning about measuring objects and ordering them in size order.</p>
RE overview	This term the children will be learning about the Greek Orthodox Saints and Feast Days. We will also be continuing our learning on The Lord's Prayer. During this term we will also be preparing the children for Easter and covering several bible stories. We will also be covering Unit 2: God Made the World.
Topic overview	We will be covering the topic of 'Transport and Vehicles.' Children will be learning about different modes of transport and comparing different vehicles. Children will also be learning what different modes of transport that they can use to travel and will be making their own vehicle out of recyclable packaging and materials.
PE overview	Games-concentrating on listening skills, turn taking. Children will also be focussing on their balance, co-ordination and gross motor skills. Children will also be introduced to dance and movement.
Music overview	Specialist Music Teacher creating music around our relevant Topic subjects (Transport and Vehicles)
Computing overview	Children will be taught to use child friendly software.
