The activities that will take place in Investigation's Week reinforce learning that is challenging and FUN and provide us with vital skills that we use in everyday life.

The theme of the week will be 'Whodunnit' which can be adapted to all the areas of learning.

Tuesday 11th

The children will be involved in class based activities related to the theme 'Whodunnit'. They will be conducting forensic investigations to solve a 'Whodunnit?' This will provide children with a realistic context in which to make systematic observations and then draw conclusions.
