Literacy Overview	Reading: Identifying fiction and non-fiction books. Drawing on and finding information from books. Children are learning to read poetry. Writing: Learning how to write sentences using full stops and capital letters. Writing letters in cursive handwriting and correctly writing letters. Spoken: Retelling and sequencing a story. Write sentences correctly using SPAG. Structure writing and use adjectives to describe settings and characters.

Maths overview	Number and Place Value: Learning to count to 100. Writing numbers beyond 100. Learning the multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Addition & Subtraction: Read number sentences to add and subtract. Add 1 digit numbers to 2 digit numbers. Subtract 1 digit numbers from 2 digit numbers. Multiplication & Division: Sharing numbers in 2 groups. Combine groups of 10. Share numbers into 10 groups
