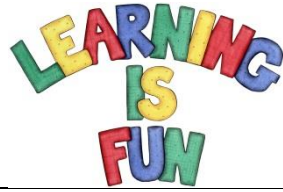


# YEAR 1 HOME LEARNING

Mathletics	Several Mathletics tasks have been set to consolidate this week's learning:  <b>Multiplying numbers.</b>
Spellodrome  Writing	Spellings will be set weekly; the children will have a week in which to practice. We recommend that children practice using the look-cover-write technique, as well as saying out loud.  This week for home learning, I have set the following Spellings:  <b>Aisle, isle, aloud, allowed, affect, effect, alter, altar, assent, ascent, bridal, bridle, cereal, serial, compliment, complement, farther, father guessed and guest.</b>  Children should practice these spellings (also available on Spellodrome) and put them into a sentence. If the children are unaware of the meaning of any of these spellings, we encourage children to use a dictionary to help them.
