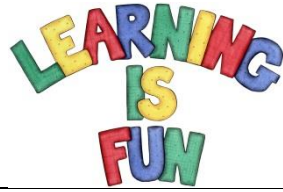


YEAR 5 HOME LEARNING

Spellodrome Writing	Spellings will be set weekly; the children will have a week in which to practice. We recommend that children practice using the look-cover-write technique, as well as saying out loud. This week for home learning, I have set the following Spellings: Gnaw, gnat, gnome, gnarled, feign, campaign, champagne, gnashed, mortgage, gourmet, depot, crochet, raspberry, breath, dreadful, heaven, leather, pleasant, especially and literature. Children should practice these spellings (also available on Spellodrome) and put them into a sentence. If the children are unaware of the meaning of any of these spellings, we encourage children to use a dictionary to help them.
