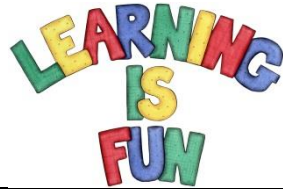


YEAR 5 HOME LEARNING

Mathletics	The children have also been set various activities to consolidate the learning from this week.
Spellodrome Writing	<p>Spellings will be set weekly; the children will have a week in which to practice. We recommend that children practice using the look-cover-write technique, as well as saying out loud.</p> <p>This week for home learning, I have set the following Spellings: <i>Calculate, candidate, cascade, dedicate, deliberate, detonate, dominate, hibernate, complete, delete, supreme, canine, examine, disguise, executive, inquire, negative, vampire, umpire and alternative.</i></p> <p>Children should practice these spellings (also available on Spellodrome) and put them into a sentence. If the children are unaware of the meaning of any of these spellings, we encourage children to use a dictionary to help them.</p>
