As you will be aware, many important decisions about this school are taken by the Governing Body. There is now a vacancy for 3 parent governors and you are invited to stand for election.

Schools and Academies have governors from all walks of life, from different ethnic groups and all age groups over 18 years old. Very few people cannot be governors. If you work at the school for more than 500 hours in any consecutive 12-month period, or are an elected member of the LA you may not stand for election as a parent governor. On the declaration of eligibility form is a list of statements which if apply also would prevent someone from becoming a school governor. The appointment is subject to a satisfactory enhanced criminal record bureau check. Therefore, if successful, you will be required to allow an application to the Criminal Records Bureau for an enhanced criminal records certificate.

If you would like to stand for election as a parent governor, or if you would like to nominate someone else, please complete the relevant section on the nomination form enclosed. If you wish to nominate someone else you will need to check that they have a child at this school and that they are willing to be a governor. You are welcome to put your own name forward.

Each person standing for election must prepare a short personal statement stating why they wish to stand for election. These statements will be circulated to parents with the ballot papers. Each person will also need to sign the two declarations, as this position meets the criteria of regulated activity in accordance with the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006 (c.47), schedule 4 Regulated Activity, Part 1.

Nomination forms, personal statements and declarations must reach us by 10am on Monday 19th September. Please place all your paperwork in a sealed envelope addressed to 'Ms Yeats – Parent Governor'. Any nominations received after this date and time will not be considered. If we receive more than 2 nominations a ballot will be arranged.
