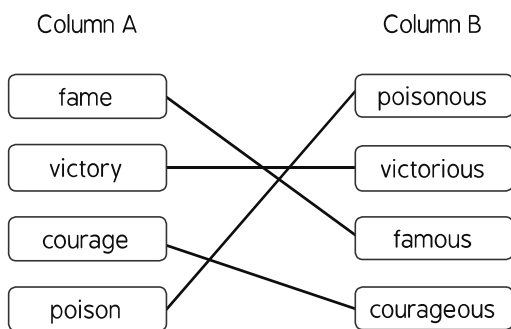


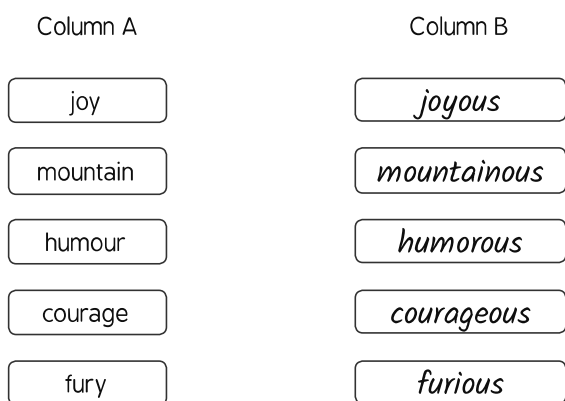
1 Match up the root word in Column A with the matching suffix ending in -ous in Column B.

3 For each of the above root words explain the rule you used to change it into an -ous word.

Word	Rule Used
joy	<i>When a word ends with a vowel and y, keep the y.</i>
mountain	<i>If none of the other rules apply we just add -ous onto the ending.</i>
humour	<i>-our is changed to -or before -ous is added.</i>
courage	<i>A final e of the root word must be kept if the word ends in ge.</i>
fury	<i>When a word ends in a consonant and y, change the y to i before the suffix -ous is added.</i>
