




Animal Clay Tiles

Supplies

- Tablecloths
- Boards
- Rolling pins
- Clay tools for finer details
- Aprons
- Clay (cut to the size of a large-ish block of butter)
- Animal pictures









Roll up your sleeves and put on your apron.




Protect the table with a tablecloth. Get a board to use as your working space.




Fetch a piece of clay that has been cut for you: approximately the size of a block of butter.



Press, knead and roll the clay. This will be very difficult at first, but the more you work it, the softer and warmer it will become. Then it will be easier to manipulate (work with).



Roll out the clay to a thickness of 1cm.



Work your animal design into the clay and shape it using clay tools. Remember not to press too hard. If you go through the tile and make a hole, you will weaken the clay.
