


Oracle Bone Model

Supplies

- A tablecloth
- An apron
- Board and rolling pin
- Chunk of modelling dough
- Modelling tools for cutting and inscribing (old rulers, pencils and paper clips also work well)







Roll up your sleeves and put on your apron.



Roll out your modelling dough on your board to a depth of about 1cm.




Cut out the shape you wish your oracle bone to be. Will it resemble a plastron or scapula?



Poke holes into your oracle bone in the bottom left corner (this was where hot metal rods would be inserted to create the cracks).



Research some of the pictograms used in the oracle bone script and use the modelling tools to carefully inscribe some onto your model.



Finally, carefully draw some lines across your oracle bone model to represent the cracks.

You could display your oracle bone models in a class gallery for everyone to see.
