Tee kánees?

How are you?

How are you?

- Καλά. Ευχαριστώ. Εσύ; / Εσείς;

- Kalá. Efharistó. Eseé? (one person) / Eseés (more than one)?

- Fine. Thank you. How about you?

- Όχι, καλά. Ευχαριστώ. Εσύ; / Εσείς;

- 'Ochi, kalá. Efharistó. Eseé (one person)? /Eseés (more than one)?

- Not very well. Thank you. How about you?

- Έτσι κι έτσι. Ευχαριστώ. Εσύ; / Εσείς;
- Έtsee ki étsee. Efharistó. Eseé (one person)? / Eseés (more than one?)
- So and so. Thank you. How about you?

Tee kánete?

How are you?

(when speaking to more than one person or to an adult to show respect)

- (all answers same as above)

C

Πώς σε λένε;

Pós se léne?

What's your name?

- Με λένε ...

- Me léne ...

- My name is ...

D

Πώς τον / τη λένε;

Pós ton /teen léne?

What's his/her name?

- Τον /Την λένε ...

- Ton / Teen léne + name

- His / Her name is ...
