WALT: Use Exclamation Marks in a sentence.

WILF: I know what an exclamation mark is and I know where to use it in a sentence. I can explain what an exclamation mark shows in a sentence.

EXCLAMATIONS

Exclamations are special kinds of statement sentences that are said with extra feeling and force. Using an exclamation mark can also show that you are being bossy! But only when you are giving commands.

Or

It can show feelings such as anger, happiness excitement

That's very strange!

Look out!

How frightening!

EXCLAMATIONS

Sometimes **exclamation marks** can be used for commands, especially when you are being bossy!

For example:
Stop that right now!

Put your coat on!

But it can also be used for statements to show how somebody might be feeling or to create excitement and suspense.

For Example.

George's grandma quickly drank the medicine. When suddenly there was a big **BANG!**



EXCLAMATIONS

- × Exclamation sentences start with a capital letter.
- × They end with an exclamation mark.
- × Practise forming exclamation marks on your mini whiteboards.



EXCLAMATIONS

When we read **exclamations** we use a slightly stronger voice than normal and we often stress one or more of the words.

Try reading these exclamations out loud:

- × *How scary is the lion!*
- × *What a terrible sight!*
- × *What a shock!*
- × *How terrifying!*
- × *The lion has wings!*
