**prepositions can also be used to tell you when something is happening.**

- 1. Tom goes to church on Sunday morning.**
- 2. I eat my dinner in the evening.**
- 3. We do PE at school in the afternoon.**

**The word 'morning' is the preposition. It tells you when he ate breakfast.**



**No, you can't play games.  
It's night time.**



**No, you can't play games.  
It's **night time**.**



The word 'night time' is a preposition. It's telling you what time of day it is.



**We are going to the zoo on the.....,

We are going to the zoo on the **weekend**, because there is no school then.



The word '??' is a preposition. It's telling us when Tim and his sister are going to the Zoo.
