

# Questions and Commands

Two of the four types of sentences in the English language.

## Questions

- Questions ask something.
- They start with a capital letter and finish with a question mark.
- They can be answered.
- They include a question word e.g. what, where, how, when, why, which, who, does, is, should...

## Examples

- How much does it cost?
- What are we having for tea?
- Where do bears live?
- What shall I do now?

## Commands

- A command is an order - giving someone an instruction or telling them to do something.
- It usually begins with an imperative bossy verb e.g. get, do, switch, tidy...
- It can be negative e.g. 'Don't stop!'
- It can end with either a full stop or an exclamation mark.

## Examples

- Stop that right now!
- Pass me the ketchup.
- Go!
- Practise your hobby whenever you can.
- Put your tooth somewhere safe.
