Prepositions are words / phrases used to describe a place (where), time (when) or cause (why).



These prepositions tell us about the **place (where)** of the animals.

The iguana is **next to** the teacher.

The dog is **on** the table.





At 6 o'clock the dog was on the floor.

Prepositions can also tell us about time (when).

During the lesson, the cat was under the table.

I haven't eaten **since** breakfast.






You will notice that some prepositions have already appeared as conjunctions or adverbs.

Other prepositions tell us about how something is caused (why) by something else.

His umbrella was ruined **because** of the storm.

Due to the barking, she put her hands over her ears.


The birthday dinner went well **thanks to** all the adult helpers.


